

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# AFFORDABILITY: Reducing Out-of-Pocket Costs



#### KP MFA: Low Income or High Expense (10%+ income)

- Forgive current debts
- No copays for specified period of time going forward (e.g., 6 months)

Increase in the use of all drugs and clinically effective drugs




