The organization has a business need for a community outreach specialist to serve in variety of different outreach efforts (Health education, Community Mammogram Program, etc.). This position could report to the Project/Program Manager/Coordinator.

Job Responsibilities

- Be Flexible and available with schedule to work non-traditional work hours (evenings and weekends) canvassing neighborhoods, attending health events and/or calling community members, zoom sessions, etc.
- Assist community members as needed (on-line, phone, paper)
- Work with Project/Program Manager/Coordinator to address issues for timely favorable solutions and outcomes.
- Go into the community to educate about various topics (i.e., Health
- Education Outreach, Community Mammogram, etc.) with emphasis on the unserved communities (African American, Latinx and Pacific Islander Community, etc.)
- Track contact with community members
- Leverage bilingual skills as needed to assist BACHAC and/or community members.
- Attend educational offerings as needed/required.

 - Exceptional verbal and written communication skills
 - Able to build and maintain strong partnerships with individuals and diverse groups (community, corporate, civic)
 - Able to take initiative, problem solve and troubleshoot.
 - Able to multi-task in an adaptive environment
